



**DRUGPRX – PARENT REQUEST XAVIER
Drugs of Abuse Screen – Parent Request
(Non-legal collection)**

Mercy Medical Center.**

PROCEDURE

1. A parent/guardian must accompany the Xavier High School student to Mercy Medical Center for testing. This service is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and 365 days per year.
2. Upon arrival at Mercy Medical Center, if it is:
 - a. **Monday thru Friday 5:30 am-6:30 pm OR Saturday 7:00 am-3:00 pm** register at the Lundy Pavilion Desk. Please indicate you are a parent/guardian of a Xavier High School student and are requesting a DRUGPRX screening.
 - b. **All other hours, go to the Laboratory located to the right of the Lundy Pavilion Desk. Call the Laboratory, using the phone by the Laboratory door.** Please indicate you are a parent/guardian of a Xavier High School student and are requesting a DRUGPRX screening.
3. The student and parent/guardian (if student under age 18) will be asked to sign a release for the following:
 - a. Consent for the collection of the urine specimen
 - b. Consent for the Sedlacek Treatment Center to notify the parent/guardian of the screen results
 - c. Consent to Treat on the back of the registration form.
4. Until further notification, the parent/guardian will not be charged for the **positive** DRUGPRX screens. The parent/guardian will be responsible for the cost of negative DRUGPRX screens after the student has had two consecutive negative screens. Insurance information may be requested at the time of registration for the purpose of filing for insurance coverage of subsequent screens.
5. Urine specimens will be obtained from the student according to Mercy Medical Center Laboratory policy.
6. Results of the DRUGPRX screen will be forwarded to the Sedlacek Treatment Center within 72 hours of collection.
7. Within 72 hours of receiving screen results, the Sedlacek Treatment Center will notify the parent /guardian of DRUGPRX screen results and discuss options for evaluation, if appropriate.
8. The DRUGPRX program is confidential. The administration and nurse at Xavier High School will **not** be notified of a student screening unless the parent/guardian decides to self report to school.
9. Results of the DRUGPRX screen are for the information of parents/guardians only. This is not a legal collection.
